The Trailblazing Girls Project aims to improve educational outcomes, encourage self-expression, empowerment and economic self-sufficiency, and create home and community environments that are conducive to success.

A BREEZE OF HOPE FOUNDATION | Bolivia

This project will provide girl victims of sexual violence with a safe and comfortable environment in which to rebuild their lives and dreams, and develop the skills they need to live successful, economically independent lives.

THE TANDANA FOUNDATION | Mali

The goal of this project is to promote women's economic independence and participation in local decision-making by improving their literacy, numeracy, association management, democratic governance and leadership skills.

AMMAN IMMAN | Niger

Through a livestock loaning program, fodder bank, and training for women in animal husbandry, this project will support the nutrition of children and provide mothers with the means to purchase food, clothing and medicine, and pay for their daughters' school materials.

This project will provide leadership training for refugee women working as early childhood educators at camps for refugees of the Darfur (Sudan) conflict.
