Off camera: I know the big picture why you are here, but what happened to your family?

Translator: The reason why we are here, the government instead of looking for rebels, they come and you know, kill us civilians. Yes, that is why we are here. We could not stay in Sudan any more because everyone is being looked for.

Translator: We are receiving food from World Food Programme, but it's not enough food, because sometimes it's inadequate and sometimes you completely lose it. And you can't send your labor anywhere. There is no work that you can do in order to earn some money, so life is not really easy.
